Mathematics: Capacity Make a Rainbow Salt Jar! (See picture in Friday's column) You will need: salt. coloured chalk, paper and a recycled glass jar with a lid (spice jar, jam jar, small coffee container etc.) Watch this video and read the instructions below.

DIY Colored Salt Made Wi..

- 1. Pour salt on a piece of paper. enough to make a layer about ½ cm thick, in your chosen container...
- 2. Take a chalk colour and rub the chalk back and forth across the salt until you get the desired colour saturation.
- 3. Carefully, pour a layer of coloured salt into the container.
- 4. Repeat the process with new colours until the jar is completely full. Take care not to shake the rainbow salt jar as this will mix the layers up.
